Lazar's Tempest is an erotic thriller, in which the sex is both very explicit and could also be described as fantasy. The story starts with an aircraft crash in Guam, the crash being caused by a total lack of electrical function due to a localized electromagnetic pulse attack by a group of terrorists. We then find that Jack Lazar is off to Hawaii for a wedding, and naturally Jack goes with plenty of time in hand, and immediately picks up a young woman, Leilani, and engages in numerous sexcapades, the endurance of which is definitely in the realms of fantasy. Shortly after this, but well into the book, the thriller part starts. Jack and Leilani are hiking up to a military installation when they come across a man who wins a fight with Jack, leaves him unconscious with a gun in his hand, the gun having killed a US Navy guard. The thriller part starts. The thriller part has its flaws too. Suppose you were the navy and a guard was killed outside a top-secret military installation in a very remote place. What would you do? Inspect the facility? Apparently this is beyond the skill of the US navy, in this book anyway. Accordingly, it is all up to Jack, and Jack eventually learns that the real problem is an impending emp attack that will fry all of the electronics on the mainland US. Jack has to save his country. Never let it be said that life was easy for Jack, but there remains frequent interludes with Leilani.

The book is well-written for what it is and the words flow easily and very smoothly. The characters are somewhat stereotyped, and we get an unnecessary policeman plod. Nevertheless, it is rather light-hearted, and if you view it as such, and as an easy-to-read entertainment not to be taken to seriously, and where realism can be put to one side, it is top-grade, and the star rating is given for that sort of book.
