Their father had been a tyrant and she'd always played the peace keeper, diverting her father's attention away from her brothers to spare them his wrath. Finally free from her father's smothering attention, she takes a spur of the moment cruise and ends up stranded in Caracas having been robbed of her purse containing her money and her passport. And to her rescue comes Antonio del Ray, a brute of a man who once had the audacity to say she lusted after him. Forced to accept his help, she ends up on his private island and finds herself unable to resist his magnetism. Antonio despises rich pampered blue blood brats, and he sees this as his opportunity to knock Ms. Landon down off her pedestal. Kyra is the only sister of Cade, Grant and Zach. She is a youngish beautiful heiress who is the apple of her daddy's eyes, and a baby in her brothers' eyes. All her life she had played the role of the perfect daughter for her control-freak father and the happy girl for her over-protective brothers. But it was all pretence. Underneath this appearance, laid an unsatisfied girl who wanted to embrace life more freely and be taken more seriously.

Antonio is a thirty-something successful half Castilian-half Mayan business man. He never knew his father and was poorer than a church's mouse. In addition, he has an issue with women born into money. His first love was an heiress who mocked and ridiculed his proposal because he did not have a blue blood.

How does Antonio, who cannot stand pampered heiresses and Kyra, who cannot stand controlling men fall in love with each other?
