Debut author Nina West will put your emotions through their paces and make your heart skip a beat in her new novel WOLF BAIT. Set in the beautiful Alaskan wilderness at an oasis destination hotel, you will meet Abbi and Henry – two very different people who have been broken by others in their lives and are desperate to break out of the mold in which they've been shoved their entire lives.

After being painfully and callously dumped by her fiancé, Abbi accepts a job thousands of miles away from her small-town home in Pennsylvania. She thinks that getting away to somewhere where no one knows who she is is exactly what her battered ego and heart need. She can gain some life experience and remake herself into a confident woman before returning home to face her ex and her overbearing family.

Abbi was not prepared for Henry Wolf.

Henry is rich, gorgeous, powerful and very intimidating. After an unexpected meeting, Henry hires Abbi as his personal assistant. He's drawn to her innocence and goodness. She's drawn to him for exactly the opposite reasons.

As a debut novel for West, I believe that *Wolf Bait* was a well done story. Those who have read romances like FSOG and the Crossfire series will find the similar trope of an older more experienced man who is paired with a younger and far less experienced (read: virginal) woman. Although the theme is familiar, I think West did a good job creating a distinguishable story.

Abbi Mitchell is a young and impressionable woman of high morals. She is in college and engaged to her childhood sweetheart, a preacher's son, when she discovers that he committed the ultimate betrayal. Using the excuse of "sowing wild oats" before he marries Abbi, he puts a pause to their relationship so he can see (and have copious amounts of sex with) other women. Abbi is devastated and heartbroken. Needed to get away from anywhere near a life that reminds her of him, she applies for a job at a high end resort in Alaska. Never imagining that she would get the job because of her lack of experience in the hospitality industry, Abbi is pleasantly surprised when she is offered the job. Escape. Freedom. Abbi is on her way to Alaska and straight into the wolf's den.

Well, that is Henry Wolf's den...errr...hotel.

Henry Wolf is rich, successful, and GORGEOUS and Abbi cannot help her instant attraction to him when she just thinks he's a sexy lumberjack. Yet, her attractions ramps up more when the lumberjack turns in the suave businessman that he is. And when she catches the eye of owner Henry Wolf her world is opened up to much more than she thought.

Henry was one of those heroes I love to hate. An enormous ass when we first meet him, he soon opens up to Abbi and proves to be every bit a domineering Alpha male. I could understand why Abbi's naivety would be alluring to him, but I had to wonder why he continued to pursue her, pushing her faith and values. He was every bit a wolf prowling for his prey.
