Finding Love's Wings was beautiful. The story, the characters, the emotions, the words; they were all beautiful. I sat down to read this and I really didn't know what to expect. This is Zoey Derrick's debut novel and I never read reviews of a book when provided with a copy and asked for an honest review. I don't want to be influenced or jaded or have my review shadowed by other reviews in my head. So, I set out to read this book and at 28% I was texting Danielle:

"HOLY SHIT! THIS BOOK IS AMAZING! I'm only at 28% and I am addicted and panting! I can't believe she asked us to review her book. Zoey Derrick is going to be huge!"

Yep, that's what I said and I'll stand by it. The heroine, Cami, is so easy to love and yet she doesn't know what to do with love because of her upbringing (or lack thereof as the case may be). In the opening chapters, you can really feel her loneliness. I felt crushed for her after Reed's infidelity, but thankfully, her character is not some young, naïve woman who sits and wallows. Cami runs. She runs to a tropical paradise to hide and

not lick her wounds as most women would do, but to gather her thoughts and make a plan. She knows that she is a damaged and understands why, but her inner strength keeps her going. Just the kind of girl I could look up to.

And then there is Tristan Michaels who is also running from the effects of a loved one's infidelity. He is supremo book boyfriend material. Being a Hollywood heartthrob, he is obviously yummy, but just like Cami, "I can't help myself. When it comes to tattoos, I'm a sucker every single time." But Tristan wasn't just some tattooed yumsicle. He was an absolute doll and the things he does when wooing Cami are just heart and panty melting sweet! He is such a good man that he was willing to take some of the heat off of the dirty slut whose actions hurt his heart and possibly his career. Who does that?

I loved that this book is not the typical "poor girl meets rich boy and he saves her from the big, bad world" storyline. These characters were strong, intelligent, and aware of what they are facing. I was instantly drawn in to this story by the way Zoey Derrick so thoroughly paints her characters. I'm not just talking about physically but, their personalities as well.
