The ad seemed too good to be true, and she wasn't sure if her brother was setting her up for a fake job or not.

It is just a short review for this one as I only lasted to the 50% mark of the story. Which is just over the minimum 3 hours of the audio (or 100 regular pages) that I give books to get a true feel of a story. It just did not really work for me. I think the premise promised the potential for a really fun comedy romance but that just never materialized as the writing was too basic and stilted to suck me into the story.

The story could have been really fun. Prince Kylin, an alien, is the crown prince of Mixis and to spur his people into being more open to taking alien spouses has decided to lead by example and advertise for a human bride! Georgia is an out of work language teacher who speaks fluent Mixian. Georgia's brother is the host and star of his own popular prank TV show and decides it would be hilarious, and good for ratings, to trick his sister into marrying the Prince. He does so by altering the marriage advertisement so it looks like the offer of a teaching job at the Palace! Mishaps ensue and before too long Kylin and Georgia find themselves in a public marriage betrothal! It should have been super fun and hilarious but Zenia lacked the talent to suck me into the story and the dialogue was a bit dull and, shockingly, lacking in humour!

This was a flop for me.
