The Queen succeeds in turning Skye into a harvester devoid of human emotion. As a harvester, Skye is desensitized to the horrors of the harvester camp which are grim and cruel. She also finds herself in complete allegiance and devotion to the Queen at the expense of all those she formally loved; Jace, Zoe, and Ian. The Queen uses AI to impregnate Zoe with triplets, the father being Ian, in hope of creating babies with a multitude of superpowers. Although humanity tries to creep into Skye's psyche, Zoe's pregnancy and the birth of the triplets awakens the human in Skye, especially Hope, the baby with a birth defect. This causes Skye to renew her fight against the queen and restores her integrity.

I did like this book, but I wasn't as excited about it as I was the first. At times, the superpowers aspect was a little over the top for me. The time traveling and appearance of Ian, Simon and Rose from the future was a bit unbelievable, especially when Ian brings back supplies for the babies from the future...please!
