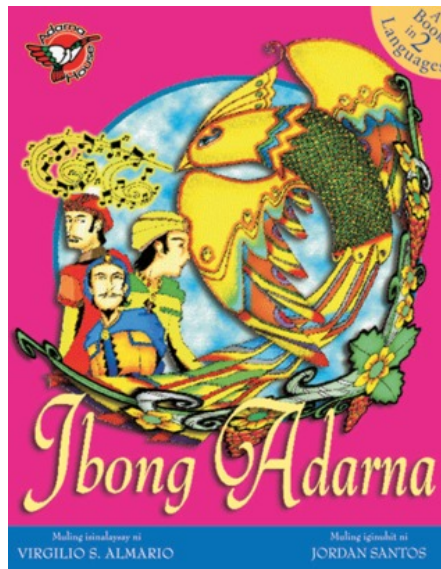

The story of *Ibong Adarna* is a required reading in many freshmen high school students in the Philippines. I think this version of the National Artist for Literature Virgilio S. Almario is the illustrated version but it sufficiently captured the essence of the story as far as I can still remember.
