My 7 year olds are big fans of Dan Gutman's Weird School series. We have read or listened (the audiotapes are fantastic too - the narrator is terrific!) to all of the books in this series. In fact, this was the first series of chapter books my kids ever read and they have never stopped being interested in whatever the next installment is even though we have been reading or listening to them for at least 2 years now.

In Miss Newman Isn't Human, Miss Newman is the local weather woman who has come to Ella Mentary School to teach the kids about meteorology. Through a meteorological mishap, her coworker, who provides her cue cards, gets taken out of commission and Miss Newman (who, we learn, has become overly dependent on her cue cards over the years) is left to fend for herself. The book had several laugh out loud moments. (One of our favorite moments was when the principal asks Miss Newman to forecast tomorrow's weather and she tells the kids that there will be showers across the country tomorrow morning as people wake up and decide they need to take a shower!). My kids enjoyed learning about a new funnily named weather phenomenon with which they were not previously familiar.

For those not familiar with the Weird School series, the kids in them are not perfect. They complain about homework and wearing raincoats and indoor recess and the cafeteria food. One character sometimes calls another dumbhead (although she secretly likes the dumbhead and is not a mean character, generally) and one character calls another a crybaby. My kids know they are not to say these things.

Many times, there is some actual teaching about science or math or some other topic (in this book, a little bit about a meteorological phenomenon) disguised in the humor. My kids still remember learning for the first time about how rainbows are formed and how light gets refracted from an early Weird School book. (Now, they have started listening to another Dan Gutman series, the Flashback Four, and are learning about Abraham Lincoln).

All in all, we really enjoyed this book in the series. I am giving it a 4 rather than 5 stars because it seemed to have slightly less heft or story than some of the other installments, but my kids truly enjoyed it.

P.S. After having shared my review of this book with my kids, they strongly disagreed. What do you MEAN that you didn't give 5 stars! So that says it all.
