Dakota only vaguely remembers a not-so-great mom. She was taken at an early age, then at 12 placed into training as a blood courtesan. At 18 the girls are sold to their vampire buyer – and today is her birthday. Roman is attractive, aloof and has his own reasons for buying Dakota.

Without giving any storyline away – I can only say that this is a unique take on the Blood Courtesan theme as these girls do not find themselves in a jam and volunteer.
