Abundance of the Infinite captures the essence of what a novella can do. The protagonist is a married psychologist who comes to learn that his unborn child is at a high risk for birth defects. While begging his wife to reconsider her decision to terminate the pregnancy, he is told on the same day that his estranged father who neglected him since early childhood has died. In a spur of panic, he leaves behind his life in Toronto to visit the small coastal town of Manta in Ecuador, where he begins to cultivate a life quite literally founded on his dreams.
