London Miller is an author I found through her collaborations with Bethany-Kris and ever since I have been frantically trying to catch up on her whole back catalogue...and I'm nearly there. I love my mafia books and while this is a spin off series about mercenaries and hackers, this started in the genre I love. Mercenaries and

hackers though...I have come to love even more. Crooks & Kings was the first book in this series and gave us our first introduction to these characters. Razvan was fondly known as Tacut, the silent one, and he has intrigued me from the very beginning. This was a book I couldn't wait to start and then never wanted to end.

London Millers writing has that effortless feel, her stories simply spill from the pages drawing you into her worlds and never letting you go until the final word is read. Her character connection is on point and the emotion in this book was one thing that totally shocked me simply because I wasn't expecting.
