Jules has never wanted to go back. Until now. Someone has threatened her best friends Venessa and Macy. They need to pay. But there is someone else she has considered risking everything for. Her husband.

"I may not know my husband very well, but he was honorable. At least I fucking hoped he was, considering I'm putting my career on the line for him."

"My heart beat for him, Bishop; my lungs took air for him. Every mission, every bust was so he could sleep safe at night. I told myself I was doing something good. I gave him everything, and in minutes he took it all away."

Almost 40 year old Maxwell Allen is a transplant to Detroit. He came from money and used his inheritance to buy his club Lush.
