Which is interesting because I still have no idea on how they transformed in the first place. I thought that Cesia had something to do with it but the manga is still not clear on that issue.

Kitchel returns so her and Thatz go on a mission together. We learn that Bierrez knows a secret about Rath and Rath is determined to kill him so that the secret can die with Bierrez. The battle continues nicely with the help of Zoma and Cesia and now that I think about it, not much happens. We see a fight and then it goes on PAUSE and then the fighting continues again.

What made me sad was Crewger's death. :( I really liked that dog and it was a real shame that he died.

The action was pretty fun but there was a ton of dialogue that brought a bunch of questions. Like Cesia's ability to talk to animals. Thatz and Rune just transforming after a fight. And the knowledge that Bierrez knows about Rath.

Kharl and Garfakcy are villains that are a lot of fun and entertaining to read. Bierrez doesn't have much to him.
