What I particularly liked about this book was the fact that it's not a case of the typical: "Somebody is murdered. Detective finds the killer." In this book, the murder happened eight years ago and there was a satisfactory conclusion to the case. Dunbar, who works for the rather mysterious Sci-Med Inspectorate, an agency that investigates crimes with links to the world of science, goes into the search for the truth believing that the psychopath is a liar so it is interesting to watch as he uncovers truths and untruths, clues and false leads, and eventually learns the truth. I found it very interesting to see the story unfold, at times with what seemed like the denouement, only to learn that another twist had been added. I would definitely recommend this book and will be looking out more works by this author.
