There was a lot that didn't work for me in this book. First, they do win the bid at the bachelor auction, but Brenda bid an amount that they couldn't cover, causing Emily to have to explain this to Tyler. Of course, after meeting Emily, Tyler decides to hire her and within a day she is traveling to Las Vegas to work with Tyler on one of his smaller companies. Emily is ecstatic. She is familiar with the company/app because she has a profile on it and has struck up a virtual friendship of sorts with another user, a guy named Lucky. They email/post everyday and Emily really looks forward to their witty interactions and just being able to talk about her day and do a little innocent flirting.
