Based on the Square Enix game *Final Fantasy Type-0*, the manga side story delves into the past of Kurasame Susaya, one of the game's key characters. In the war-torn country of Rubrum, young cadets train at a prestigious magical academy in the hopes of becoming "Agito," saviours of legend that are prophesized to save Rubrum, and the rest of the world, from destruction.

The Ice Reaper takes readers back in time to Kurasame's beginnings as a cadet and plants the seeds for his tragic rise to fame as one of the Four Champions of Rubrum. During what was to a harmless class outing, unexpected danger throws the students into a struggle for their lives. In the aftermath of the attack, gripped with loss and under suspicion for their role in the disaster, Kurasame and his fellow survivors must contemplate what their future as cadets holds for them.

Evocative illustrations and a compelling first volume make the *The Ice Reaper* a fun read both for people finding the series for the first time and for the fans of the original game. A good choice for anyone looking for a mature action series to sink their teeth into.
