When Dustin arrives all dressed up with roses, Sean is sure he forgot something important, but Dustin tells him it's fine and they head out for a late dinner. Sean still feels that something is going on that he's missing, but Dustin is not upset. Sean has had unfortunate luck with boyfriends in the past who are less than patient with his artistic temperament.

They get to the fancy restaurant and when Sean opens the menu, he finally realizes the truth, it's Valentine's Day. He can't believe that Dustin didn't tell him, but he's told that as long as they spend time together, it doesn't matter the day. There is some reminiscing about how they met but I really would have liked to see more of them as a couple outside of the few hours they are together.
