I found this book incredibly easy to read, it was quick, easy and had a good plot with well rounded characters. However, at times I felt I was reading a fan fiction, and found some of the exchanges between Avery and Hadley to be extremely cliched, sometimes bordering on banal. Despite this, while reading I did feel like the narrator (Hadley) was given a very realistic teenage voice

Spoilers:

I felt that Hadley's flashbacks of the accident were sometimes quite repetitive. Although I understand that flashbacks were necessary to show how she had been affected, a few times the exact same description of the accident was used, almost like a copy and paste had been used.

I found Jenny's character to be somewhat annoying, especially in the exchange between her and Hadley post funeral. I didn't feel it was realistic that she would have got into the car and immediately chastised Hadley at her own parents funeral. That said, her character develops into a somewhat likeable person after Hadley had lived with her for a while.

I also feel that perhaps Andrew should have had a bigger role in the story, after all Hadley did live with him too! I'd have liked to see more of his relationship with Hadley, and also with Avery.

Avery's character was a favourite from his first mention. It's not common to have an alternative individual as a romantic lead in any book, and it was refreshing to see. I feel that his relationship with Hadley developed very quickly, but in a teenage relationship so filled with dramas that's not impossible.

Overall I really did enjoy this book, but at times felt it was for a younger audience. However, I understand that that may be because I'm used to slightly more mature content. I would recommend this book to people between the ages of perhaps 14 and 17 depending on maturity.

In addition to grieving the tragic loss, she's also dealing with survivor's guilt, and the knowledge that her last words to her father were less than kind.

Her Aunt Jenny (her mom's sister) makes a 9 hour drive to help Hadley make funeral arrangements and then helps Hadley pack up her belongings and brings her back to Texas to live with her and her husband Andrew and his brother Avery, so they can help her get through her pain (both physical pain and mental pain).
