My first grader really enjoyed not only the rhyming phrases - which helped her to read it out loud on her own - but also all the whimsical and beautiful watercolor illustrations. In my experience when reading aloud to young readers not only is a good story line important, but also captivating and inviting illustrations are needed to engage and keep their attention. Ms. Richmond was both author AND illustrator and she does a fantastic job in both. We both found ourselves giggling at many of the scenes (mainly because we've been in those situations or we have done something similar) and the facial expressions Ms. Richmond captured.

The text is rather simple, straightforward and rather poetic. It is a story about mothers and the lengths they would go through to make their children happy, giving several different examples. While written in prose, it didn't flow all too well and some of the rhyming scheme seems forced and the melody seems to change frequently. The illustrations are somewhat drawn well – reminiscent of children's water painting, but emphasizes the prose rather well.

The premise of the book is rather straightforward. It gives several examples of the lengths mothers would go through to make their children happy with very little if any thanks for their work. This book is a celebration of the unpredictable adventure that motherhood brings. Sometimes it's silly, always heartfelt, every moment extremely important and more importantly rooted in love.

All in all, *Oh, The Things My Mom Will Do....: Because She Loves Me Through and Through!* is a wonderful children's book celebrating the wonderful adventure that is motherhood and what they would go through for their children – and happily do it too.

A good reminder for children aged 4 and up of all the ways their mom shows her love, whether it's sitting up at night with a sick hamster, dealing with a sick child or making it to a special event at school, all with the refrain "Oh, the things my mom will do... because she loves me through and through!" (I'm sure you'll hear your child chanting it with you as you progress through the book.)

The illustrations fit the age group, as if a child had drawn them, and the words roll nicely off your tongue for reading out loud. There's a great rhythm there, but some of the concepts (like the speeding ticket) seem to be put in more for the adults reading the story than the child audience. All in all, a sweet book that mothers can read (and add their own stories to) while reinforcing how much their love their child.

Any mom will recognize herself in the day to day activities of taking care of a child, whether it's delivering a forgotten lunch, cradling a sick child or nursing a guinea pig back to health. Moms do it because they love you.

The mother-child relationship is told through rhyme with a refrain that children will repeat during a read aloud. The story is better for older children who will recognize their moms and will put themselves in the book's story.

The fun illustrations show a harried mother and a child who knows he can depend on mom through and through. Each picture shows Mom fixing whatever needs to be fixed and even though Mom may have other things going on she finds the time, the materials and the love to get the job done. “Oh, the things my mom will do... because she loves me through and through!”

A smiling mother stands on the front porch of her family home with the beloved family dog and waves goodbye to her children as they find their way off to school. Touching imagery of course, but what was left out of that description is something to which parents can all relate. Imagine that same mother but with frazzled hair, a ragged old housecoat and only one slipper situated on her foot. That is the image displayed on the opening page of Oh, The Things My Mom Will Do.

“Our family’s busy every day. Seems mom is gone a lot. She asks me to please understand. I pretend, but I do not.”

In Miss Richmond’s newest book, we read the story of a typical child who cheerfully goes to school without their lunch kit, misplaces toys, forgets important school assignments until the day before its due and, of course, spreads worms out onto the carpet. Through it all is an amazingly wondrous mother who is always there to chase after the bus in her jammies, sans slipper, to make sure her child has lunch. A mother who loses sleep while making a special costume for a school play and makes pet invertebrates a home inside her home. She also finds teddy before bed, makes it to the party on time, and at the end of the day, is there to tuck you in and say goodnight.

A mother’s work is never done and often goes unnoticed. Sometimes, when life feels rushed and hectic and Junior really does forget his bear in the grocery store shopping cart, mom has to search through every single cart in the corral before it shows up...these are the moments that mom’s might chalk up to as an “experience”, but it’ll be a moment in time that a child will remember forever. Maybe even a story to tell their grandchildren one day when expressing their love for the older generation of family members, all because mom managed to save the day...again.

Oh, The Things My Mom Will Do is a remarkably illustrated, poignantly written hardcover children’s book with recognizable experiences that will tug at any parent’s heart and resplendent imagery that will occupy a child’s mind. While this book is meant for children ages 4 and up, a child of a younger age will also be able to perceive the imagery and possibly tell the story through pictures. The author is able to show children that they shouldn’t take their mother for granted and understand that even in her absence her thoughts are always on the well-being of her child.

Oh, The Things My Mom Will Do captures the no-so-routine moments of parenthood in rhyming verses. The cadence is fun to read, and the illustrations are funny in a way that a mom will understand and the children will chuckle at. It is a great book to read as a family, and kids around five and up will be able to appreciate the story and the message about all the crazy things moms do for their children. However, I think this book is also great for a read by moms- all by themselves- if they can get the five minutes alone it would take.

I would recommend Oh, The Things My Mom Will Do to families and libraries to add to their collection. It is great for group reading. However, I think the best use of this book would be as a gift for Mothers Day, Baby Shower, or any mother or grandmother (or other guardian) that you want to show appreciation too. Just acknowledging the amount a mother does, and showing that it is noticed and much appreciated, is the best gift of all.
