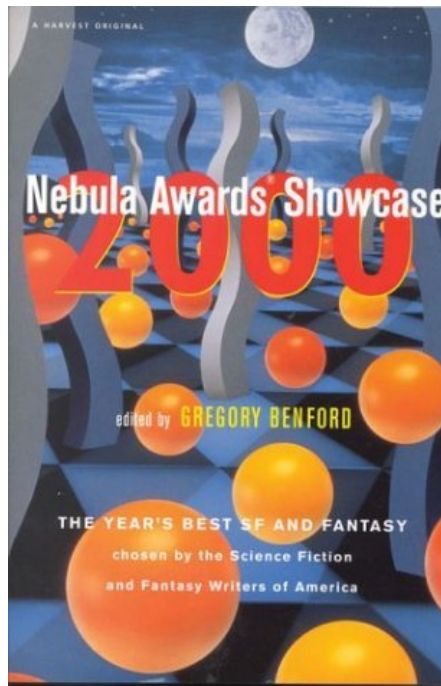




Nebula Awards Showcase 2000: The Year's Best SF and Fantasy Chosen by the Science-Fiction and Fantasy Writers

If you bother to read the whining (and counter polemics) about the state of the art and business, then also read the essay by William Tenn [Phil Klass] where he amusingly defines the essence of SF as 'quarrelsomeness.'
