The final volume takes place in the Gizzard, pub and dimensional nexus point for fiction. Thool has taken control of everyone there, so our heroes have to fight everything that moves. When it looks like they are defeated, Taxthalmus enters the scene with a horde of demons. He was an enemy in the first story arc. The Gizzard's bartender has control over who has access to the place and he is under Hool's mind controll too, so we see several more Baldy/Shorty characters from other dimensions/genres fighting in the big finale.
