Although neither is interested in a relationship, they become close and must face their own past issues of rejection and abandonment before they can move forward.

Other than the BDSM element, this is a pretty typical romance trope, i.e., transcending one's past, whether that be past failed relationships or family issues. Both are present in this book. The characters are well drawn. The BDSM is handled sensitively and knowledgeably. In fact, this is a good primer novel for those who have an interest in learning more.

I'm rating this a 4 just because the plot devices are pretty typical. But I do recommend it.
