I'm not sure I'm huge on Brennan being back in the spotlight, it isn't that he's a bad character; rather, that the two don't mesh and he had his spotlight 2 books back; and E has always been darker, edgier; (It's almost like Bren was the go to because the author couldn't figure out anything else for him.)
