As I'm one of the contributors to the anthology, I'm not rating this book even though I personally think it's a wonderful collection (but of course I'm biased).

The anthology consists of 15 romantic stories from 14 different authors around the world. Some of the writers have many book titles to their name, others are emerging or debut authors. Some of the stories are more classic romance, some are sweet, others include fantasy, adventure, suspense or mystery. Some have a fluid and beautiful style, some are inspiring, some are surprising, some are erotic, some are imaginative while others just took my breath away. All the stories are written from the heart and include a reference to a pink ribbon to honor those who are (or have been) affected by breast cancer.

To me *Tied in Pink* is like a box of chocolates - each story has its own unique flavour; some sweet, some spicy, some leaving you thinking long after you read them and some bringing you to tears. This is an anthology of romantic short stories by Aussie authors from various walks of life. Some of the stories are fantasies, some are contemporary and some have historical elements. Some are quite steamy while others are more subtle or sweet. One thing they have in common is a united desire to earn money for breast cancer research, so I hope they sell like hot cakes.

Some of the stories deal with breast cancer patients and survivors as main characters. Even the ones that don't directly deal with breast cancer have little hidden motifs. I found myself beginning to look out for references to pink ribbons - a bit like a 'Where's Wally' book for an excellent cause, so good on them.

I liked some of the stories better than others, which I guess is bound to be the case when so many different authors are involved. Most readers will probably say the same, and prefer different selections. I've heard it said that a book of short stories is a bit like a box of chocolates. Every reader will find something that suits them.
