Sweet Liar was everything I hoped it'd be and more; it had all I've come to expect from a Laurelin Paige story - a hooking storyline, fun and relatable characters, and sizzling chemistry between those characters that'll leave you a gasping mess. But more so it had all I've come to know and love from a story set in her Dirty Universe - a hero who is dirty filthy rich, a heroine who is fierce and fiery to the core, and a unique storyline that sucked me in from the very beginning.

It's a story I'd been highly anticipating to read ever since that moment in *Dirty Filthy Rich Love* when Audrey let slip that she'd kissed Dylan Locke, a man who's not just co-CEO of the company her sister works for, but a man who is also twenty years her senior, and *that* right there was the kind of story I wanted to read. Though I'll admit, I'm always hesitant to read age-gap romances, mainly because the ones I've read before in the past *have* ended up being huge disappointments. But I think it's safe to say - going by my **five star** rating - that I was *not* disappointed with all that Laurelin delivered here in *Sweet Liar*.

An age-gap romance that's also a swooning Daddy-foreplay romance is what this novella is all about, one that, at first, had me *howling* with laughter (*mainly at Dylan's cluelessness*), before then leaving me a gasping mess at the chemistry that only ever continued to grow between these two characters the more it is their story went on - their funny, unique, dirty, filthy, and just *downright* sexy story.

Attraction is a funny thing. Writing attraction is a sticky, difficult thing and it is done very well in this title. (Originally published as a serial in Laurelin Paige's newsletter.)

Sometimes, you are attracted to a person you meet on the subway, someone who is age appropriate and you have similar interests, and are in similar places in your life.

Other times, you are attracted to a coworker, she is 19 years younger than you, and you aren't sure if you have the same interests, as she is young enough to be your daughter.

Dylan and Audrey are the latter. She's a subordinate, she works for the company, and she asks him to kiss her...he's powerless to refuse her, and he doesn't want to resist her. As a reader, you FEEL this attraction, his desire to do something that he knows (or thinks) is wrong, but wants to do so badly. This is the main tension of the book, and the reason that the scenes with Audrey and Dylan are so damn hot.

But, she is young, and he feels bad, like this isn't something he should pursue. However, when she pursues him? When she goes with him to appointments, comes on to him, and makes it clear that she wants him, and knows what she is asking for? Well, there is no way he is going to turn her down.

Yes, this is a story on a timeline, they have a week (or so) before both of them move on to other things, other places in their lives, and go back to their real lives. So, what is the harm in pursuing the relationship? Nothing, as long as you don't fall in love.

OOPS.

Technically, this doesn't end on a cliffhanger...but it does end with you wanting to know what happens next.

As always, this title is full of characters you like and ones you want to know more about. As always, Laurelin Paige delivers a story you love and don't want to put down.

In her Dirty world, Laurelin Paige has introduced us so far to the quiet, stormy, edgy-beyond-words Donovan Kincaid (SWOON) and the sunnier, optimistic, heart-open-to-love Weston King. Now we have Dylan Locke, who believes that his heart reflects his last name.

Dylan takes his repressed Britishness to near extreme lengths as he tries to avoid falling for Audrey Lind, the younger sister of Sabrina, the woman who captured Dylan's business partner Donovan. She's in her early twenties, compared to Dylan having hit forty, and that age difference only further entrenches his reluctance to get involved with her.

As the title states, though, there is a liar in this book, and that liar is Dylan. The biggest lies he tells, of course, are those he tells to himself. He thinks he has barricaded his heart from fresh bruising, and he thinks he is impervious to longing and affection. It's up to Audrey to prove him wrong, a challenge she gleefully accepts.

My favorite parts of this book are when we're in Dylan's head. Laurelin Paige shows just how hard he works to reject love, and just how fruitless those endeavors may prove to be. Audrey's narration, while lighter, gives you a chance to understand why she finds herself drawn to this curmudgeon. She is so youthful and vibrant that you would expect Dylan's reluctance and resistance to repel her. Laurelin Paige, though, lets you see what Audrey sees: Dylan is a man yearning to love and be loved.

I defy you not to follow for Dylan. He captured my heart as quickly as he captured Audrey's, and when the sexy times come (no pun intended), you will love each detail, each moment, each sigh and caress and moan. Dylan, dear readers. DYLAN. He is divine.

The ending makes you feel a little lonely, a little bereft, in a way. You want more. You have questions you want answers. The good news is that Sweet Fate is coming your way without too long of a wait. Of course, it's entirely worth every second.
